

F2 - Autumn 1 - New Beginnings

Literacy

Learners will develop a love of reading.
Learners will read individual graphemes by saying the phonemes for them.
Learners will begin to read simple CVVC words & captions.
Learners will use popular & repeated phrases from teaching texts to develop their vocabulary.

Phonics

Children will learn the GPC's for
s,a,t,p,i,n,m,d,g,o,c,k,c,k,e,u,r,h,b,f,l,l,ss,ff

Communication & Language

Learners will learn to listen and know why listening is important.
Through the teaching texts, learners will develop a wide vocabulary and use this in every day conversations with adults and peers.
Children will communicate through role play, developing and expanding on their thoughts & experiences and new vocabulary.

Physical Development

Learners will develop their fine motor skills through the use of simple tools, e.g. scissors, pencils for drawing and writing pincers threading patterns.
Learners will safely navigate their way around the outdoor apparatus, running, skipping, crawling peddling and negotiating space safely.

Expressive Arts & Design

Learners will have many opportunities to select and use a variety of artistic styles to create imaginative pieces of art linked to autumn and Harvest, including painting, rubbing, printing, clay modelling & drawing..

Understanding the World

Learners will take part in autumn walks around the school, observing signs of autumn.
Learners will create simple routes that characters from the texts may take.
Learners will observe how they have changed since being born and create simple timelines of their life so far.
Learners will learn about and celebrate harvest traditions and learn about the source of food.
Learners will be encouraged to talk about their families and special people in their lives.

Teaching Texts



Personal, Social & Emotional Development

Learners will feel valued and see themselves as a special individual in their new setting.
Learners will develop constructive & positive relationships with their peers and adults.
Learners will establish new routines and expectations.

Mathematics

Learners will begin to develop a deep understanding of number through sabotaging and exploring the composition of numbers to 5.
Learners will develop their understanding of prepositional language, e.g. on under over behind in front next to.
Learners will develop their understanding of capacity, using vocabulary such as full, empty, half full

F2 - Autumn 2 - Celebrations Around the World

Literacy

Learners will say, spell say words using their decoding phonics knowledge link to the GP sees. Learn common, exception words (read words) that, I, he, she, is, two, go, of, as, we, all, you, into.

Leaders will learn digraphs, begin to apply them in their reading and writing.

Phonics

Learners will learn the GPC's for j,v,w,x,y,z,zz,qu,ch,sh,th,ng

Communication & Language

Learners will ask questions to find out and explore different celebrations around the world.

Learners will use full stem sentences in a speech to elaborate and extend their thinking.

Learners will be able to describe a variety of worldwide celebrations in some detail. Learners will use their listening skills to recognise rhyme & rhythm in the teaching texts.

Physical Development

Through cultural dancing, learners will progress towards a more fluent style of moving with developing control and grace.

Learners will develop their overall body strength and co-ordination by experiencing a variety of climbing apparatus.

Learners will develop the foundations of our handwriting style.

Expressive Arts & Design

Learners will have many opportunities to select and use a variety of artistic styles to create imaginative pieces of art linked to autumn and Harvest, including painting, rubbing, printing, clay modelling & drawing..

Understanding the World

Learners will understand that some places are special to members of their community. Learners will recognise that people have different beliefs and celebrate special times in different ways eg Diwali, Christmas. Learners will observe seasonal changes, focusing on the winter season, describing what they see, hear and feel when being outside.



Teaching Texts

Personal, Social & Emotional Development

Through cultural studies, learners will learn to respect and discuss the perspectives of others. Learners will express their feelings and carefully consider the feelings of others.

Mathematics

Learners will develop their understanding of 1 more/1 less. Learners will link the numeral to the cardinal number value e.g. the fourness of four etc. Learners will recognise that a shape can have other shapes within it, just as numbers can.
