During the last half term, our year 6 pupils will be getting 'high school' ready by working with different members of the team to prepare them for the next stage of their learning journey.

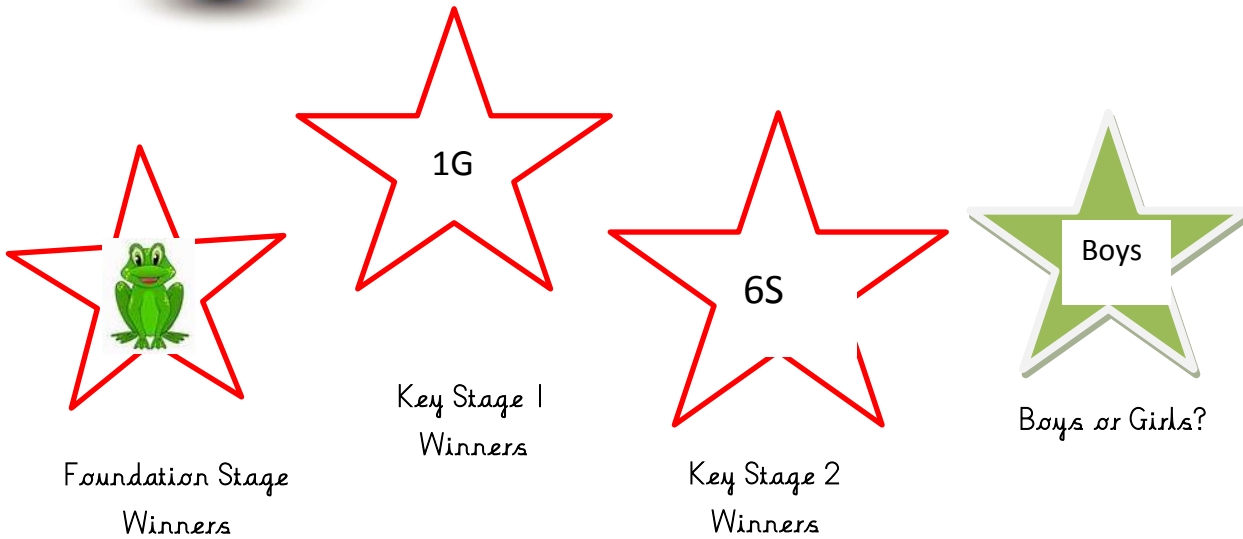
