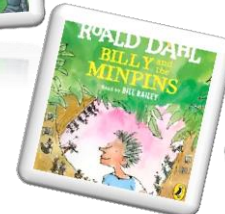
**2 pupils from Early Years: The Very Hungry Caterpillar**
